## Learning this half term

### English

In English, we will be reading the Nowhere Emporium. We will use it to answer reading comprehension questions as well as write our own suspense narratives and biographies.

### Maths

In Maths, we will be recapping our place value knowledge including rounding, roman numerals and negative numbers.

### Science

In Science, we will be learning about the classification work of Carl Linnaeus including classification keys of vertebrates and invertebrates.

### RE

In RE, we will be discussing the question 'creation or science – complementary or conflicting?'

### French

This half term we will be exploring French transport.

### Music

In Music, our topic is South and West Africa. We will learn to play a 'Shosholoza' using percussion.

### PE

### Design Technology
