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
#### Day to day routine

## Homework

### TTRS – 10 minutes Daily

Access TTRS on Jamming and Garage to improve scores and eventually "Go Green" (recall all timestables in under 4 seconds).

### Spelling

Alongside their statutory spellings the children will also have weekly spellings, these will be tested every Friday.

### LBQ Homework (Year 3)

Your child will access an independent weekly study.
