## **Class 3 WW2 Day – Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> May 2026**

We are excited to have planned an engaging and educational experience for our children in Years 4, 5 and 6, focusing on a pivotal moment in history – World War II.

On Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> May, we will hold a Dress Up Day (optional), inviting pupils to come to school dressed as a child from the years 1939 to 1945.

This special day is designed to immerse our students in the history of World War II, allowing them to explore important themes such as: evacuation, rationing, VE Day, and the various aspects of wartime life and jobs. Through this experience, we hope to foster a deeper understanding of the challenges and resilience faced by children during this significant period in history.

We encourage your child to participate by dressing in appropriate attire from the era. This could include clothing from the 1940s such as simple dresses, trousers, or accessories that reflect the time. If your child does not wish to dress up, they can still participate in all the activities planned for the day.

In addition to the dress-up event, we have organised a variety of interactive activities and history workshops throughout the day that will provide the pupils with insight into the past. We aim to make history come alive through storytelling, games, and hands-on projects that reflect life during World War II.
