<u>Homework</u>

We really appreciate the time taken to support your child at home and can really see the difference this makes to your child's progress.

Children are to complete the following homework each week;

- Reading daily
- Numbots
- Phonics weekly recap sheet
- Maths

Your child has a homework book; this is where any homework is to be completed and recorded (unless uploaded to SeeSaw or brought into school). Below, there is additional topic-based homework that can be completed over the half term to deepen and extend knowledge learnt in school, your child may choose to create their own idea for their topic homework. This needs to be handed in on SeeSaw / homework book / emailed across by Monday 20th October. The children will choose a library book from the school library every Friday to share at home. This is a sharing book and is to be enjoyed and shared together, it is not matched to their reading level.

This is your topic homework for this half term, please pick and choose which activities you would like to complete. There is no set amount you need to do. You can add pictures onto Seesaw, email them to the class teacher or write/draw in the homework book by Monday 20th October.

Take a walk around your house.

Make a list of things you can see, hear, touch, taste and smell.

Can you use recyclable materials to create your own instrument? Maybe you will use cardboard or plastic. Is your instrument tuned or untuned?

Speak to your parents/grandparents about their life as a child.

Learning this half term



















In R.E. we will be thinking about what is special about our world. We will be looking at the natural world around us exploring things we find interesting, looking after nature and wildlife and thinking about how we can look after our world.



In Science, we will be looking at sensitive bodies. We will be exploring how we see the world around us using our 5 senses and how each of these senses work ... involving some exciting practical activities!



In <u>Art</u>, we will be looking at exploring line and shape. We will practise during different lines to music and connecting lines to create shapes. Our artist focus this half term will be Paul Klee.



In **PSHE**, we will be thinking about family and relationships. We will be thinking about what makes a good friendship and exploring how our emotions may make us feel.

In <u>History</u>, we will be looking at our personal chronology - how we have changed from being a baby, how we celebrate special events and learning about what life was like as a child for our parents and grandparents.

In Music, we will be exploring what instruments are and how they can be grouped for an orchestra. We will be practising playing some tuned/untuned instruments with a beat.


In P.E, we will be combining Indoor athletics and multi skills, practising our bat and ball skills with Miss Miller once a week and Harrogate Town once a week.



In **Computing** we will be learning how to log in to our Purple Mash accounts and exploring how these accounts can be used safely. We will learn to keep our passwords safe too!

In English, our focus will be on progressing our writing into Year 1. We will be continuing to develop independent writing of sentences, producing descriptive sentences, caption writing and an information-based poster with our new book focus.

Phonics will continue daily.



In Maths, our focus will be on place value within 10.

We will be recapping counting, looking at numbers written as words, counting backwards, adding 1 more and 1 less, comparing groups and numbers and ordering objects and numbers.
