Alongside their statutory spellings the children will also have weekly spellings, these will be tested every Friday.

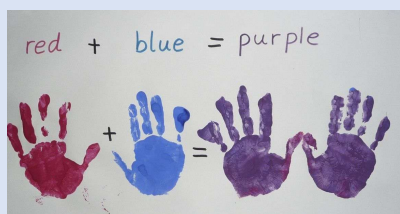

Colour splash

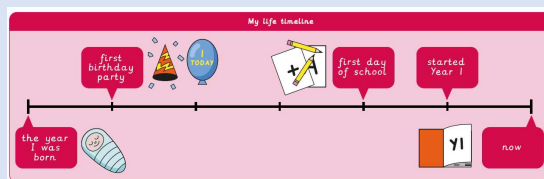
Make a list of the primary colours. Mix these together to find out the secondary colour.

Create a personal timeline by ordering events correctly on a simple timeline.

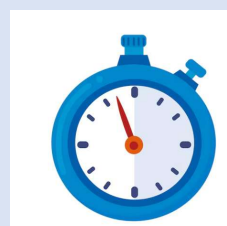

Learning this half term

R.E

What do some people believe God looks like?

Exploring how other people understand God on Earth; considering different representations of God and understanding why this is challenging.

Computing

Introduction to purple mash

This unit introduces Purple Mash to children and the essential basic knowledge and skills required. Through a range of activities, children will learn about 2Dos, saving work and navigating to key areas.

Music

Seaside: Dynamics

Exploring the connection between sound and the environment, pupils work together to create a seaside soundscape using percussion instruments, vocal sounds and body percussion.

Science

Plants: Introduction to plants

Identifying and naming a variety of plants and investigating if beans need water for growth.

Art

Painting and mixed media: Colour splash

The children will be learning about primary and secondary colours, colour mixing techniques and applying these skills in painting and printing.

PSHE

My healthy self: How can we look after our emotions?

Recognising and naming a range of emotions, pupils learn to identify facial and body clues linked to feelings.

Class 2 Curriculum Overview

History

What is History

This unit will introduce pupils to the concept of history by helping them explore their own past and understand the difference between past and present.

Maths

Place value and addition and subtraction.

Develop understanding of place value and use this knowledge to add and subtract numbers using practical resources, mental or written methods to explain their reasoning.

English
