Day to day routine

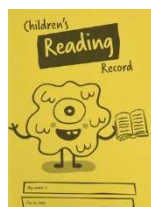

In Science, we will be learning about how reflective space blankets are.

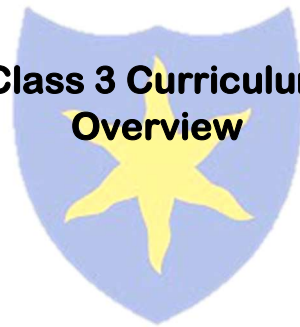
RE
