Homework

We really appreciate the time taken to support your child at home and can see the difference it makes to your child's progress.

Children should aim to complete the below weekly:

- Reading daily (please ensure reading records are signed weekly) When reading with your child, please discuss any new vocabulary they encounter and encourage them to use it in different contexts thus building on their existing knowledge.
- Statutory spellings Please learn the Spring 1 words.
- Times Table Rockstars and Spelling shed. These make a tremendous difference to the children's progress and the more they can do the better. Several short sessions are more effective than one longer one.

Below, there is additional topic-based homework that can be completed over the half term to deepen and extend knowledge learned in school. This needs to be handed in / emailed to admin or submitted on See-Saw by <u>Monday 31st March</u>. This will enable us to share the children's wonderful work at the end of the half term.

History – Design an Egyptian scroll with information about the Egyptians on it. Can you include some hieroglyphs?

Maths - work out some fractions for your family and present them as a fact file. What fraction are children, female, pets? What fraction of rooms in your house are kitchens or bedrooms etc.?

Science - Experiment:

How far away can you hear different sounds? Walk away from various sounds and record how far you can get before you cant hear them any more. Was the furthest the one you expected? What is happening that allows you to hear this one?

Homework ideas

DT - Can you create a fact file about racing cars? What do you know about their design and why they are made like that?

Basketball

Draw a map of a basketball court with positions and the rules on it.

Computing - Use Purplemash to create a blog using skills from Autumn term. You can also comment on the class blog.

English How long can you manage to keep a diary for? Write about what has happened or how you feel. Try to include lots of things that you have done that make you feel good.

 Outline all of the qualities that

 good British Citizens.
