Day to day routine

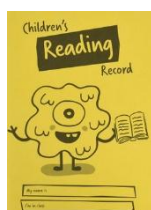

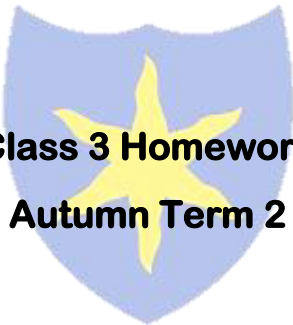

Learning this half term

English
