<u>Homework</u>

We really appreciate the time taken to support your child at home and can really see the difference this makes to your child's progress.

Children are to complete the following homework each week;

- Reading daily
- Numbots
- Phonics weekly recap sheet
- Maths

Your child has a homework book; this is where any homework is to be completed and recorded (unless uploaded to SeeSaw or brought into school). Below, there is additional topic-based homework that can be completed over the half term to deepen and extend knowledge learnt in school, your child may choose to create their own idea for their topic homework. This needs to be handed in on SeeSaw / homework book / emailed across by Monday 15th December 2025. The children will choose a library book from the school library every Friday to share at home. This is a sharing book and is to be enjoyed and shared together, it is not matched to their reading level.

This is your topic homework for this half term, please pick and choose which activities you would like to complete. There is no set amount you need to do. You can add pictures onto Seesaw, email them to the class teacher or write/draw in the homework book by Monday 15th December 2025.

Take a tour of your house and evaluate different objects. Can you make a table of different materials used? (plastic, glass, rubber, wood)

Which material can you find the most of in your house?

Take a picture of somewhere you go (park, seaside, grandma's house, church etc) and write about why it is special to you. What do you like about going there?

Thinking about emotion, can you create your own dance to a song that fills you with happiness and makes you want to move and groove?

Learning this half term

In <u>R.E.</u> we will be thinking about which places are special and why. This will see us explore where might feel special to us personally, as well as learning about where Muslims and Christians special place is.



In <u>Science</u>, we will be looking at uses of everyday materials. Our learning will support us in identifying what material objects are made from and recognise properties that make materials suitable for their uses.



In <u>DT</u>, we will be looking at cooking! Super exciting. We will be researching different fruits, thinking about the characteristics of fruit/vegetables, making a design brief and creating our own smoothies.



In <u>Music</u>, we will be exploring celebration music (Diwali, Hanukkah, Kwanza) as well as practising our Christmas celebration songs. We will be comparing how music is different for different celebrations.

In <u>PSHE</u>, we will be thinking about our own health and wellbeing. We will be exploring our own emotions and how we can use these to set goals as well as to develop a growth mindset.




<u>In P.E</u>, we will be combining dance with a pirate themed fitness session. We will be developing our physical fitness as well as defining our dance moves!





In <u>Computing</u> we will be learning how technology can support us with grouping and sorting. We will be practising our maths skills with sorting and grouping by characteristics.

In <u>English</u>, our focus will be on continuing to develop our writing, as well as a big focus on our handwriting!

In <u>Maths</u>, our focus will be on addition and subtraction (within 10). We will be extending on our learning of partwhole models by using fact families and number bonds to support our understanding of addition/subtraction.
