## Curriculum Overview Statement: EYFS

## <u>Intent</u>

Within the federation of Ripley, Beckwithshaw and Kettlesing Felliscliffe, we aim for our youngest learners to feel safe, valued and inspired every day. We encourage our educational, spiritual and moral drive throughout the school, beginning in Early Years: Growing together, guided by love.

At the heart of our Early Years, we hold a simple belief: every child can DREAM BIG.

At our federation, we believe that strong communication and language skills are the foundation for future learning. Our EYFS provision is intentionally language-rich, prioritising oracy so that children can confidently express themselves, listen actively, and engage with others.

In our mixed-age classroom, children benefit from a unique dynamic: younger children are immersed in a wide range of vocabulary and sentence structures, which supports them in developing more complex language skills. They learn from the rich talk and advanced vocabulary modelled by older peers, as well as from adults. We help children to find their voice, build friendships, and grow in confidence.

Our curriculum is thematic, engaging, and play-based, ensuring that children explore a broad range of experiences in meaningful contexts. It is carefully planned to be progressive, enabling every child to build on prior learning, make connections, and develop the knowledge, skills, and attitudes they need for the next stage of their education. We balance intrinsic motivation with academic learning complemented by elective opportunities and enhancements that enrich children's experiences and broaden their horizons.

Our provision is underpinned by the federations three C's

- Community fostering a strong sense of belonging where every child feels included and valued. We encourages students to engage with one another and collaborate on projects that foster connections within our school and the wider community.
- Compassion listen actively, respond thoughtfully, and engage empathetically with their peers whilst expressing their feelings and supporting one another, fostering a sense of belonging and community spirit.
- Courage embrace challenges and voice their opinions, even in difficult situations, taking risks in their communication and standing firm in their beliefs.

In the Early Years, we are committed to enabling every child to **DREAM BIG**, find their voice, build friendships and grow in confidence – ready to thrive as lifelong learners. - A Aspire together: Using the strength of our mixed-age class so children learn collaboratively, support each other, and inspire one another.
- M Make meaningful links: Designing a thematic, connected curriculum that helps children build knowledge progressively as well as helping them to understand the world around them.
- **B** Be brave: Encouraging resilience, risk-taking, and confidence in sharing ideas.
- I Imagine and create: Providing open-ended resources and experiences that promote creativity and problem solving. Children's creativity and curiosity are celebrated every day.
- **G Grow for the future**: We prepare children for their next steps with strong foundations in language, literacy, maths and personal development.
