

Below, there is additional topic-based homework that can be completed over the half term to deepen and extend knowledge learnt in school. This needs to be handed in on SeeSaw / homework book / emailed across by **Monday 10th February**. The children will choose a library book from the school library every Friday to share at home. This is a sharing book and is to be enjoyed and shared together, it is not matched to their reading level.

Practise using column addition/subtraction to add and subtract 2-digit numbers.


Choose an animal and draw/label what it eats.

In R.E. we will be looking at Which times are special and why?

We will be looking at different types of celebrations such as:

Sukkot a Jewish celebration.

Diwali a Hindu celebration

Christmas a Christian celebration

Learning this half term

In Science, we will be looking at
Animals: Comparing Animals.

We will be comparing and grouping animals based on similarities and differences in their characteristics, physical features and diets.

In History, we will be looking at 'How did we learn how to fly'.

We will be delving into the Wright Brothers and looking at when the first flight was, as well as looking at Bessie Coleman and Amelia Earheart.


In PSHE we will be thinking about Economic Wellbeing. We will be exploring ways to keep money safe, think about the value of money and the role of banks and building societies.

In Maths we will be looking at 2D and 3D shapes as well as completing addition and subtraction within 100.



In DT, we will be looking at 'Wheels and Axles'.

We will be learning about the key parts of a wheeled vehicle, the children develop an understanding of how wheels, axles and axle holders work while designing and making a moving vehicle.

Learning Overview



In Music, we will be looking at keeping the pulse together through music and movement, by exploring their favourite things..

In PE, we will be learning how to play Dodgeball as well as Boccia which is a precision ball sport, similar to bocce, and related to bowls and pétanque.



In Computing we will be focusing on 'Maze Runners' where we will be learning to understand the functionality of the direction keys as well as learning to understand how to create and debug a set of instructions.



In English our focus text will be 'Miranda the Explorer'.

We will be looking at creating a setting description based on another place she may go and visit. We will be using adjectives, expanded noun phrases and similes to create this.

We will be also focusing on one place she visited and will gather facts and create an information leaflet on that place.
