Homework

Below, there is additional topic-based homework that can be completed over the half term to deepen and extend knowledge learnt in school. This needs to be handed in on SeeSaw / homework book / emailed across by **Monday 13th July**. The children will choose a library book from the school library every Friday to share at home. This is a sharing book and is to be enjoyed and shared together, it is not matched to their reading level.

This is your topic homework for this half term, please pick and choose which activities you would like to complete. There is no set amount you need to do. You can add pictures onto Seesaw, email them to the class teacher or write/draw in the homework book by **Monday 13th July**.

Decorate a shoe box to make an underwater scene. Maybe you could include: fish, seaweed, sand, rocks.

Practise writing your numbers all the way to 20!

Explore 2D/3D shapes around your home. Can you use the objects to create a picture?



Make a fish picture using circles, triangles, squares and/or rectangles. Can you name the shapes used?

Can you use recycled materials to make a sea creature? Maybe a jellyfish, fish or starfish.

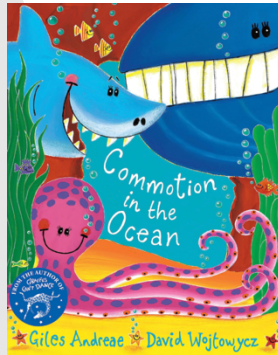

Learning this half term

In **Literacy and Topic**, we will be looking at the theme 'Under the Sea'.

We will be looking at animals that live under the sea, habitats under the sea, different types of oceans and plastic pollution.

We will be exploring different texts including 'Commotion in the Ocean', 'Meet the Oceans', 'Clean Up' and 'Brilliant Boats'.



In **Expressive arts and Design**, we will be creating different animals found under the sea using a variety of art resources (paint, colours, playdough, paper plates etc).



In **Maths** we will be focusing on sharing and grouping numbers and quantities. We will look at what happens when you share an even/odd number and doubles.

We will also be exploring shape manipulation and construction using different 2D shapes.
