Dear Parents and Carers,

A reminder that sports day is at Ripley cricket ground from 1pm on Wednesday 24th June.

Children are to come to school in school PE bottoms and trainers that morning, and wear a T-Shirt in their house colours. This should be a plain T-Shirt in one of the following 3 colours, depending on your child's house:

Yellow - Daffodil
Green- Shamrock
Red - Rose

Children should bring a waterproof coat, a school PE hoodie, and a named water bottle. To avoid lost property due to it being a federation event, please ensure no school bags are brought into school that day, only a lunch bag/box if applicable, to minimise the number of belongings being taken to the cricket ground.

Children at Kettlesing and Beckwithshaw will be transported to the cricket ground by coach. Please ensure you have completed the travel permissions on Arbor no later than **Friday 19th June**. Normal village permissions apply for Ripley pupils who will walk to the event. **ALL children should be collected from Ripley cricket ground when the event officially finishes at 3pm**. To ensure we safeguard all children across the federation when dismissing children on the day, we ask that at the end of the event you remain in the spectators area and staff will give further instructions on the day, and come to you to sign out and dismiss your child/children.

Parking for this event will be free of charge from 12-4pm in the main Ripley village car park, overflow section, directly adjacent to the cricket ground. To access this car park, take an immediate left when you enter the carpark and drive onto the flat grass area. Ensure you park in rows to allow others to get out if required.

Please be aware that the whole carpark area operates on a camera system, and parking will only be free for those who park in the correct designated area during the hours of 12-4pm as detailed above. If you chose to park in the main car park area, or those around the village, you will need to pay for parking, this includes blue badge holders. Any fines incurred are not the responsibility of the Federation. Therefore, please use the parking area allocated for the event.

Our amazing Friends (PTA) across the federation will be selling refreshments, ice creams and fun things throughout the afternoon, so be sure to bring your card/cash with you.

Please note that any photos/videos taken on the day that include other children are not to be shared on social platforms, including What's App, as we have several children across the federation who do not have photo permissions.
