Year 6 Bikeability – June 2026

We are delighted that this year Dave Burns will be returning to our Federation to deliver Level 1 and Level 2 Bikeability (cycling proficiency) at all three schools for our Year 6 pupils.

The sessions will take place as follows:

Tuesday 9th June - All Schools Level 1

Dave will visit each school and deliver Level 1 Bikeability, in the playground/village cycle track, to all participating Year 6 pupils.

Wednesday 10th June – Level 2 Kettlesing

Dave will visit school, delivering level 2 on the local roads.


Thursday 11th June - Level 2 Beckwithshaw and Ripley

Due to the unsuitability of the roads surrounding Beckwithshaw School, all participating Year 6 pupils are requested to attend Ripley Endowed CE Primary School for the day. Beckwithshaw parents should drop their children off at Ripley for 8:30am and collect at 3:15pm. If you require free wraparound care for siblings that day to accommodate the different location, please let Mrs O'Connell know. If your child is normally on a school dinner, they will receive a meal whilst at Ripley for the day. Mrs O'Connell and Mrs Randall will liaise regarding menu options that match your child's current choice and inform you of any alternatives if required.

Attached to this letter is further information about your child's instructor, Dave Burns, what your child will need to bring on both days, and information regarding the course. There is also a permissions form that needs to be completed and returned to the school office by **Tuesday 5th May 2026**. By completing the permissions you are agreeing to your child taking level 1 and 2 Bikeability, including going out on local roads with Dave Burns at the locations outlined above.
